

27 - CHIEF PHARMACIST

There are 80 posts of Chief Pharmacists in the state (notified by H.P. Government vide Health-A (3)-30/94, dated May 1997. He will be responsible for :

1. They will be responsible for medicine store at Districts / Sub-Divisional level in order to ensure adequate and timely supply of medicines to the Medical Institutions.
2. Filling up of abstract register under guidance of the SMO.
3. Supervision of Pharmacy / Administrative / National Programme if and when desired by SMO/ Civil Surgeon / Medical Suptdt.
4. They will accompany the SMO / Drug Inspector, at the time of inspection if they so desire for their help. It will completely discretionary for the SMO / Drug Inspector to seek the help of Chief Pharmacist.
5. In addition to above the Chief Pharmacist will also perform their usual duties of Pharmacist.
6. Where there is a Chief Pharmacist, the casual leave application of Pharmacist of the same institution is routed through the Chief Pharmacist.
