40 - PEON

- He will be on duty half an hour before working hours of the office/hospital in which he works and leave half an hour after the office hours.
- He will attend to dusting of the tables, chairs, doors, windows and walls of the office/hospital area allotted to him.
- 3. He will see that the sweeper cleans floors, toilets, and etc. daily before office/hospital hours.
- 4. He will announce the arrival of visitors to the officer concerned and help them to meet the officer in an orderly manner.
- 5. He will attend to the telephone calls when the officer is not on his seat.
- 6. He will carry the files from one seat to another or to and from the officer as required.
- 7. He will run errands an official business within the hospital and out side if necessary.
- 8. He will bring tea and other refreshments to the concerned officer when required and do other odd jobs at headquarters.
- 9. He will expeditiously deliver the outgoing mail to the addresses, post office and bring in the coming mail from the post office.
- 10. He will assist in packing parcels, closing and stamping of letters.
- When required by a responsible officer he will do the duties of chowkidar or a gate peon.
- 12. He will assist moving in stores of the hospital as required and also go to the bank to encash Cheque etc. Maximum weights to be carried out not exceed 10 Kgs.
- When work in hospital / wards he will work as stretcher-bearer, do dressings under the supervision of Nursing Staff.
- 14. He will call the Doctors or other hospital staffs on second on call duty during emergency.
- 15. He will assist the Nursing Staff in bringing the medical store item from district store to the wards.
- 16. He will prepare the cases for surgery as directed by the Nursing Staff / Surgeon.
- 17. He will assist the OTA / Theatre Nurse in autoclaving and preparing the dressing drums for use during surgery.
- 18. He will carry the oxygen cylinder, suction operators, I/V stands to and fro in the wards on the direction of the Nursing Staff.
- 19. He will observe all the universal precaution for infection control as per the manual.
- 20. He will daily wear the uniform provided to him by the Department.
- 21. He will do such other duties as may be allotted to him by the hospital authorities.
- 22. Any other job assigned by the Head of Office.
