20 - WARD SISTER

JOB SUMMARY

Nursing Sister / Ward Sister is accountable for the Nursing Care Management of a ward and unit assigned to her. She is responsible to the Nursing Superintendent / Matron for her ward management. She take full charge of the ward and assign work for various categories of Nursing or Non-Nursing personnel working with her. She is responsible for safety and comfort of her patients in her ward. In a teaching hospital she is expected to ensure good learning fields.

- Assists in planning and administration of therapeutic diet to her patients.
- Sees that helpless patients are regularly fed as per direction.
- Assists patient and his / her relatives to adjust in the hospital and its routine.
- Makes list of condemnation of articles and submit it to all concerned.
- Establishes and reinforces ward standards prescribe in the procedures and manuals of the ward.
- Sees that ward statistics are regularly submitted.
- Reports about the medico-legal cases in the ward.

Ward sister/Head Nurse is directly responsible for the management of a single nursing unit / department/ ward. She is accountable to the nursing service administration office but directly responsible to Matron.

a) DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN RELATION TO BE LEADERSHIP OF HER TEAM:

- 1. (a) Should have knowledge of every individual patients needs and nursing problems.
 - (b) Each member's educational and professional efficiency and personality.
 - (c) Hospital policies, rules regulations and ward policies.
- 2. Assigning each staff to patients and various functions.
- 3. Assigning duties and responsibilities to class IV personnel.
- 4. Interpreting ward routines and policies to each personnel.
- 5. Supervising and guiding all personnel
- 6. Evaluation of each person's performances on a regular systematic method
- 7. Maintaining the attendance register for each personnel
- 8. Maintaining a good working relationship among all members in the ward.
- 9. Helping in organizing in service training and educational programmes within the ward.
- 10. Arranging for some special clinical talk or demonstration in her ward.

(b) RESPONSIBILITIES TOWARDS PATIENT CARE

- 1. She is responsible for providing good nursing care to all the patients in her ward for 24 hours a day.
- Responsible for admission and discharge patients.

- To ensure proper for patient comfort and hygiene, administration of medicines, musing 3. procedures, observations of patient's conditions and recording.
- Responsible for proper diet for patients. 4.
- Carrying out the medical care delegated by the doctor. 5.
- Assistance to medical staff in examination of patients and treatment 6.
- Assistance at a supervision of clinical investigations operations and post-operations. 7.
- Rounds with medical officer. 8.
- Maintenance of patients record. 9.
- Intimation of Doctor of any special emergency or change in any patients condition 10.
- Immediate intimation to doctor of any accident or incident occurs to patients i.e. fall of 11. patient, wrong medicine administered, burns etc.
